Objectives

To reduce new HIV infection among youth by raising their risk perception through Life Skill Education and creating awareness on Sex, Sexuality and HIV/AIDS.

1. To induce among youth the spirit to help and support people living with HIV/AIDS (PLWHA) thereby reducing stigma and discrimination against people living with HIV/AIDS.
2. To motivate youth and build their capacity as peer educators and change agents by developing their skills on leadership, negotiation and team building.
3. To promote voluntary non- remunerated blood donation among youth

RRC regular activities being carried out at the college level

- Imparting 6 to 10 hour sessions on the curriculum “ Celebrating Life”
- Peer education and leadership training
- Competitions (Debates, Quiz, Drawing and Painting)
- Interactions with positive people
- Interaction with ICTC, ART, Blood Bank Medical Officers and Counselors and Transgender
- Peer leaders conventions
- Awareness campaigns (rallies, out reach activities) and exposure visit
